JCI, introducing “Mobile Broadband” to Japanese customers
with InfinityCare GLOBAL – USA
Service is provided on the Verizon Wireless network

On February 10, 2006 Japan Communications Inc. (hereafter JCI) announced that it would launch “InfinityCare GLOBAL – USA”, a precursor to its full data communication services in the United States. InfinityCare GLOBAL – USA is a data transmission service that allows Japanese Enterprise customers with frequent US business travel requirements, immediate and unfettered access to mobile broadband services (CDMA2000 1x EV-DO / 1x RTT) upon arrival in the United States.

1. Particulars

JCI is an MVNO (Mobile Virtual Network Operator), which instead of owning its own network, procures wireless communication network access from domestic and international mobile telecommunication service providers and thereby offers a range of data transmission services.

As announced in the press release of December 6, 2005, JCI recently signed a wholesale mobile data contract with Cellco Partnership (New Jersey, USA), the second largest mobile carrier in the United States and the owner of the network service branded Verizon Wireless.¹ In accordance with the December 6 press release, JCI is furthering its preparations towards offering this and other services in the United States. These services will be built around JCI’s US consolidated subsidiary Computer and Communication Technologies, Inc. (hereafter CCT) and will put to use the vast expertise and know-how that JCI has cultivated through operating in the world’s most advanced mobile data communications market, Japan.

A precursor to its full US-based data communications services, JCI will launch “InfinityCare Global – USA” on March 1, 2006. This service will allow Japanese Enterprise customers traveling to the United States on business use of mobile broadband data communication services immediately upon arrival. Transport service is provided on the Verizon Wireless network.
