However, because stock acquisition and other costs are expected, the consolidated Predicted Business Performance for the March 2006 period (April 1, 2005 to March 31, 2006) disclosed on March 18, 2005 shall be amended as above. The non-consolidated Predicted Business Performance shall not be amended.
