Until now, access to wireless LAN spots has been based on JCI’s network exchange system, whereby one day of access to a particular spot was granted in exchange for two days of PHS connectivity.

Currently, there are over 9,800 such wireless LAN spots nationwide, and their use is spreading from larger metropolitan areas to mid-sized cities. Due to this customer demand, we are expanding service to provide unlimited use of wireless LAN spots. This expanded service will target both new and existing Personal IPS customers.
