**DoCoMo extends all-you-can-use data plans such as Pake Houdai to JCI's MVNO services**

Since December 2007, Japan Communications Inc. (JCI) has offered, through its interconnection with NTT DoCoMo's (DoCoMo) 3G mobile phones, the *KeitaiPC* service, which allows corporate e-mail to be sent/received over FOMA phones. In the same manner, the *ConnectMail* service enables e-mail services provided by ISPs to be used on FOMA phones in the exact same way that consumers currently use i-mode mail. JCI's subsidiary TANGO Communications, a regional MVNO, also provides *tangomail* – a service which will bring Mobile E-mail Portability (MEP) to mobile phones.

While customers are required to pay DoCoMo the packet communication charges for these services, until now JCI's MVNO offerings had been exempt from DoCoMo's flat rate packet plans “Pake Houdai” and “Pake Houdai Furu”. This has caused customers unnecessary inconvenience.

From April 1, the packet communication charges for all MVNO services offered by the JCI Group will be included within the scope of DoCoMo's flat rate data communication plans.

The following JCI MVNO services will immediately be included in DoCoMo's flat rate data communication plans. Furthermore, all ISPs added to the ConnectMail service will be automatically included in DoCoMo's flat rate plans.

- *KeitaiPC* service for Enterprise
- *ConnectMail* (for .Mac Mail / for Gmail® / @nifty Mail)
- *tangomail* (Provided by TANGO Communications)
