JCIUS subsidiary CSCT wins ATM connectivity deal

Communications Security and Compliance Technologies Inc. (CSCT, Inc is headquartered in Georgia, USA, D/B/A Contour Networks), a wholly owned US subsidiary of Japan Communications Inc. providing Data MVNO services in the US market, is pleased to announce a major deployment of CSCT’s cellular data services designed for financial transactions with ATM World.

ATM World will implement over the next two to three years a solution from CSCT that enables its approximately 5,000 ATMs (Automated Teller Machines) to securely connect via CSCT’s wireless data solution to its payments processor. This constitutes one of the largest deployments in the US of any cellular data service to ATM machines. The financial impact of this deployment will total approximately \$3.2M when completed.

The solution includes a JBM Electronics cellular router and CSCT’s Telecom Battery™ and network services, operated out of its highly available, redundant data centers in Atlanta and Denver. This network solution increases flexibility and reduces cost of deployment of ATM machines. With CSCT’s private network, ATM operators receive the same level of security benefit found in leased wireline services.

“We are excited about the transition from our current dial-up connections to CSCT’s wireless data solution,” says Fred Wich, CEO of ATM World. “Not only will this transition save us well over half of our current connectivity costs, it will make our ATMs easier and less expensive to deploy, increase mobility, and provide us with the management tools we need in order to effectively operate this segment of our business.”

The possible current fiscal year financial impact of this agreement may be issued at a later time if and when it becomes available and if it is considered to be important.
